- Website to be launched by 2011
- SB 1235, sponsored by Sen. Tom O'Halleran (R-Sedona), signed July 7, 2008.

Georgia

- Website to be launched by Jan. 2009
- SB 300, sponsored by Sen. Chip Rogers (R-Woodstock), signed into law in May 2008.

Hawaii

- Website to be launched by Jan. 2009
- HB 122, sponsored by Rep. Markus Oshiro (D-Wahiawa), became law without gov's signature in 2007.

Louisiana

- Website to be launched no later than Jan. 2009
- SB 37, sponsored by Sen. Joel Chiasson (D-Destrehan); signed into law in March 2007.

Maryland

- Website to be launched by Jan. 2009
- HB 358, sponsored by Del. Warren Miller (R-Annapolis); signed into law in May 2008.

Minnesota

- Effective date for website was Jan. 1, 2008
- HF 376, sponsored by Rep. Erik Paulsen (R-Eden Prairie), signed into law in June 2007.

Mississippi

- No firm implementation date set
- HB 101, subst. HB 725, sponsored by Rep. Toby Barker (R- Hattiesburg), signed into law in April 2008.

Utah

- Website to be launched by May 15, 2009
- SB 38, sponsored by Sen. Wayne Niederhauser (R- Sandy), signed into law in March 2008.

Washington

- Website to be launched by Jan. 2009
- SB 6818, sponsored by Sen. Eric Oemig (D-Kirkland); signed into law in April 2008.
